Finding Books in the Dean B. Ellis Library

All books in the library are arranged by subject using the Library of Congress classification system for call numbers and subject headings. The call number for physical therapy begins with "R". The basic breakdown is as follows:

RD792 – RD811	-	Orthopedics Surgery, Physical Rehabilitation
RM695 – RM893	-	Physical Medicine. Physical Therapy
RM930 – RM931	-	Rehabilitation Therapy
RM950	-	Rehabilitation Technology

The numbers that follow these beginning letters relate to the narrower scope of the item, for example: Occupational Therapy - Rehabilitation (RM735). Occasionally a totally different call number will appear. This means the item is about more than physical therapy and higher importance was given to the other subject when the call number was assigned.
