Please note: this guide is only a starting point for your research, it is not meant to be a comprehensive list of resources. Finding Books In The Dean B. Ellis Library

All books in the library are arranged by subject using the Library of Congress classification system for call numbers and subject headings. The call number for social work begins with “H”. The basic breakdown is as follows:

H1 –H99	-	Social Sciences (General)
HM401 – HM1281	-	Sociology (General)
HN1 – HN995	-	Social History and Conditions, Social Problems, Social Reform
HQ1 – HQ2044	-	Family, Marriage, Women
HT51 – HT1595	-	Communities, Classes, Races
HV1 – HV9960	-	Social Pathology, Social and Public Welfare, Criminology

The numbers that follow these beginning letters relate to the narrower scope of the item, for example: U.S. Local History - Arkansas - Craighead County (F417 .C8) vs. U.S. Local History – Arkansas Greene County (F417 .G8). Occasionally a totally different call number will appear. This means the item is about more than social work and higher importance was given to the other subject when the call number was assigned.
