



SUMMARY OF STUDENT GRADUATION RATES


Arkansas State University-Jonesboro (ASUJ)

 **Graduation Rates for Full-Time, First-Time Freshmen Athletes** (2003-2004 Cohort) - Based on the 2009 Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) Graduation Rate Survey (GRS), the 6-year graduation rate for 2003 full-time, first-time freshmen receiving athletic aid at ASUJ was 57.5%. Historically, ASUJ full-time, first-time freshmen receiving athletic aid have had graduation rates as follows:

 **Graduation Rates for Undergraduate Transfer Athletes** (2003-2004 Cohort) - The 6-year graduation rate for 2003 undergraduate transfer athletes receiving athletic aid at ASUJ was 60.7%. Historically, ASUJ undergraduate transfer athletes receiving athletic aid have had graduation rates as follows:

 **Graduation Rates for All Full-Time, First-Time Freshmen** (2003-2004 Cohort) - Based on the 2009 Consortium of Student Retention Survey (CSRDE), the 6-year graduation rate for 2003 full-time, first-time freshmen at ASUJ was 38.0%. Unlike the graduation rate for student athletes, this figure includes all freshmen--students receiving scholarships and non-scholarship students. From 1994 to 2003, the 6-year graduation rate for all full-time, first-time freshmen has average 38.0%. Historically, ASUJ full-time, first-time freshmen have had graduation rates as follows:
