Housing Preferences

o Apartment Complexes include fully furnished Collegiate Park and the New Apartments. Collegiate Park consists of all private bedrooms in two-bedroom/two-bathroom, two-bedroom/one-bathroom, four-bedroom/two bathroom flats and four-bedroom/two-bathroom townhouses. The New Apartment Complex consists of two-bedroom/two bath, two-bedroom/one bath, three bedroom/1 bath, and four/two bedroom apartments. Students who have at the start of the contract period Junior class status (60 earned credit hours) are qualified to live in either Apartment Complex. **Contracts are for the academic year and can be extended for the summer months.**

o Residence Halls consists of Arkansas Hall, Kays Hall, University Hall, and Northpark Quads. Arkansas Hall, Kays Hall, University Hall, have a suite style arrangement with a bathroom joining the bedrooms (for first year students only). The quads in Northpark Quads consists of four bedrooms with a living room and two bathrooms. **Contracts are for the academic year.**

o Honors Living Learning Community is a combination or double room suites with a shared bathroom (for first year students) and single room suites with a shared bathroom (for upper-class students). **(Students living in the Honors LLC must be accepted into the Honors College prior to assignment). Contracts are for the academic year.**
