

Rob Reep, a 2009 graduate of Arkansas State University, is currently the owner and chief historian of a new publication and online on-demand documentary channel called Fossil HD.

After graduating from Arkansas State University in 2009 with a B.A. in history, Reep moved back home to Warren, Arkansas and continued to run a small production company he started just years earlier named Raptorproductions. On May 20, 2011, Rob founded Fossil HD, a history, humanities, and sciences online magazine. Since May of 2011, Fossil HD has grown rapidly. It now consists of a website, iPad magazine, and an iPhone application, all of which have daily academic news from around the globe, intriguing feature articles, and an on-demand, high definition documentary channel.

Rob is an award winning writer and documentary filmmaker. His film credentials include the web series, *Watch Out! History's Coming*, in which he was the host. He was also the producer and host of *The Land of Tall Pines* and *Pink Tomatoes* and *Hounding History* season one. Rob has travelled extensively, logging in over 100,000 miles of exploratory adventure. Along with being the founder and chief historian of Fossil HD, Rob is also an active feature writer, docudrama host, and videographer for Fossil HD.
